Designer's TIP

When creating a gift set, patterned paper is a fun way to add color and depth to your stamped images without having to color images.

MATERIALS

- › Cardstock: Neenah (white); Stampin' Up! (baja breeze)
- › Echo Park Everyday Eclectic 6 x 6 Paper Pad
- › Paper Smooches Hullabaloo stamp set
- › Ink pads: Clearsnap (black); Stampin' Up! (baja breeze)
- › Copic® marker: BG32
- › DMC white embroidery floss
- › Want2Scrap Beautiful Bling Borders—Endless Waves!
- › Spellbinders™ die templates: Standard Circles LG (#S4-114), Standard Circles SM (#S4-116), Labels Twenty-Nine (#S5-156)
- › Spellbinders™ Grand Calibur®
- › Paper crimper
- › SCRAPBOOK ADHESIVES BY 3L™: adhesive runner, adhesive foam squares, double-sided tape

Designer's TIP

Use these containers for other fun holidays; fill with confetti for your Fourth of July celebration and adorn with firecracker images.



Card

- 1.** Form a 4¼ x 5½-inch card from white cardstock.
- 2.** Place card on top of #5 Labels Twenty-Nine die template (4½ x 3⅜ inches) leaving top one-third uncovered; cut to create card shape.
- 3.** Using #5 Labels Twenty-Nine die template, cut a label from white cardstock; adhere to card front.
- 4.** Using same die template, cut and emboss a label from hexagon patterned paper; cut in half and adhere to bottom half of card.
- 5.** Using #4 Standard Circles SM die template, cut and emboss a 2⅞-inch circle from white cardstock.
- 6.** Using #4 Standard Circles LG die template, cut and emboss a 2⅞-inch circle from light blue cardstock.
- 7.** Referring to photo, stamp sentiment and balloon onto white circle with black ink. **Note:** Balloon will extend past circle's edge.

8. Stamp balloon onto hexagon patterned paper; cut out and adhere over balloon on circle.

9. Color a piece of white floss with marker. Cut to 1 inch and adhere one end of length to bottom of balloon.

10. Use foam squares to adhere white circle to light blue circle.

11. Add rhinestones to card. Adhere layered circle to card as shown with foam squares.

Treat Containers

- 1.** Cut a 5½ x 8½-inch piece of light blue cardstock.
- 2.** Apply adhesive to one short end of cardstock and adhere to opposite end to create a tube shape.
- 3.** Apply adhesive to one open end and secure closed; crimp end to create edge.
- 4.** On opposite end, apply adhesive so tube closes in opposite direction from first end; crimp to create edge.
- 5.** Attach rhinestones to container.
- 6.** Using #4 Standard Circles LG die template, cut and emboss a 2⅞-inch circle from white cardstock.
- 7.** Using #5 Standard Circles SM die template, cut and emboss a 2⅞-inch circle from hexagon patterned paper.
- 8.** Stamp present onto white circle with black ink; stamp bow with light blue ink. Stamp present again onto hexagon patterned paper; cut out and adhere over stamped present on white circle.
- 9.** Use foam squares to adhere circles together. Adhere to treat container with double-sided tape.
- 10.** Repeat steps 1–9 as desired for additional treat containers. 🍬
